Let your local library be your guide to information, events, programs and a warm welcome. We can help direct you to the services you need to make our community your new home.

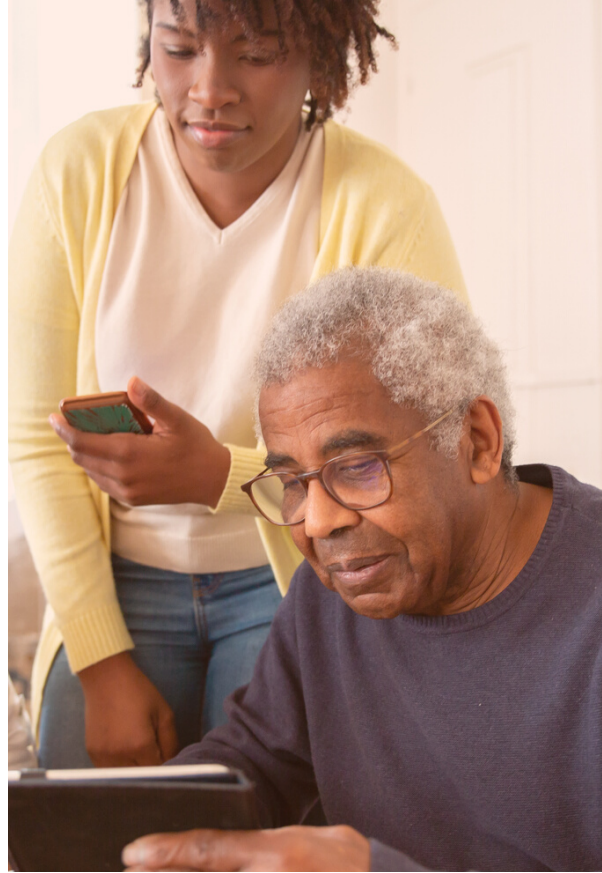
Library Services

The library collection has 100 000+ books in a variety of formats (eBooks, audiobooks, downloadable, DVDs and Playaways, Large Print, Braille and multilingual) for readers of all ages.

We also carry 5500+ of movie DVDs and TV series box sets. The library collection includes newspapers, and magazines - from here and around the world – in print, and downloadable.

Reference and research resources online, and in-person assistance. Free access with your library card is also provided to virtual library services online, such as - TumbleBooks, Press Reader, Rocket Languages, hoopla, Chilton's Auto Repair, Ancestry.ca and NovaStory.ca.

And throughout the year, we offer various items for loan such as - PlayPacks, Nordic Walking Poles, snowshoes, Fun Fit Passes, Arts are for Everyone Passes, telescopes, Radon Detector kits, Fidget Kits, and more! All you need is your library card!



Borrowing...

- **Borrowing period is 3 weeks.** You can renew your materials for longer through our website or at your preferred library – if no one else has reserved the item to borrow after you.
- **Renew online.** Visit ‘My Account’ section of www.parl.ns.ca, and login into your library account using the barcode number on the back of your library card, and your PIN.
- **Lost your card or need to update your information?** Call us at 1 (902) 755-6031 or toll-free at 1 (866) 779-7761.

Internet Access. Each library location is a free public Wi-Fi hotspot (both inside, and outside the library) and offers several Public Access computers. There are additional costs for printing, photocopying, FAXing, and 3Dprinting.

Community Spaces. The library is able to provide meeting and gathering space to the community, and not-for-profit use is free.

Programming, for all ages. The library has plenty of free programs and events for all to choose from, from Scavenger Hunts, to Family Storytimes and Book Clubs, Crafting Circles, workshops, author readings, presentations, and more – both in-person and online.

Interlibrary Loan (ILL) & Borrow Anywhere Return Anywhere (BARA): We can place a request for you through our ILL Service and borrow the material from another library system. The BARA service allows library card holders to borrow, in-person, from other participating libraries and return borrowed books to any other participating library in Nova Scotia.
